GOAL 1

Actions:

1.1.1 We will embed integrated data-gathering and feedback systems to benchmark SAC's performance against external education standards and make data-driven decisions through continuous internal monitoring and stakeholder engagement.

1.1.2 We will review our organisational structure using examples of exemplary institutions and feedback from all stakeholders to ensure that our organisation structures meet the evolving needs of the school.

1.1.3 We will establish partnerships with other schools or organizations to share best practices and innovations.

GOAL 2

We will foster a culture of continuous professional learning, collaboration, and knowledge sharing to enhance teaching, learning, and organizational development.

Actions:

1.2.1: Create a data-driven annual professional development plan that includes workshops, coaching, and peer learning opportunities.

1.2.2: Implement ongoing mentorship programs for new and aspiring faculty members.

1.2.3: Investigate ways for faculty and staff to use meeting times and spaces to plan collaboratively, reflect, and share knowledge, best practices, and innovations.





1.2.4: Develop our faculty and staff orientation into an interactive, collaborative process that emphasizes SAC's culture, traditions, and expectations while fostering relationships, teamwork, and professional learning opportunities.

1.2.5: We will model and grow distributed leadership by designing and implementing a leadership development program for senior and middle leaders, ensuring shared responsibility and decision-making authority across all levels.

GOAL 3



Actions:

1.3.1 Develop a comprehensive sustainability framework that integrates financial, environmental, and social metrics to guide strategic and operational decision-making, supporting long-term resilience and adaptability.

1.3.2 Create a sustainability dashboard to track and report on SAC's financial health, carbon footprint, and social impact annually, ensuring progress is transparent and data-driven.

Actions

- 2.1.1 Establish professional learning communities focused on implementing current research in teaching practices aligned with our guiding statements.
- 2.1.2 We will develop approaches to retaining faculty and staff whose experience supports our values and goals.
- 2.1.3 We will support faculty in publishing and sharing best practices, within SAC and the broader educational community.
- 2.1.4 We will create an annual review process for teaching methodologies to ensure alignment with the latest educational research.

GOAL 2

We will provide inclusive academic and social programs in which diversity is celebrated and students feel safe and valued regardless of their backgrounds and which nurtures the personal growth of all students.

Actions

- 2.2.1 We will explore ways of developing our co-curricular and extracurricular programs on and off campus.
- 2.2.2 We will refine and develop policies that ensure our programs are inclusive and support student initiatives.





We will strengthen our curricular, co-curricular, and extracurricular programs that enable our students to develop ethical use of technology and "respect for themselves, others, and the environment."

Actions

- 2.3.1 Ensure continuous improvement of elective offerings by conducting an annual review of student needs, industry trends, and higher education requirements.
- 2.3.2 We will develop metrics for assessing digital and global citizenship competencies and monitor progress annually.
- 2.3.1 Develop a monitoring framework to track the integration of SAC's guiding statements in all curricular, co-curricular, and extracurricular programs.

Actions

- 3.1.2 We will promote a positive organisational culture by protecting our community's work-life balance with workload management systems and distributed responsibility frameworks to enhance staff well-being and ensure sustainable leadership practices.

GOAL 2

We will prioritize the development of school culture and traditions that foster an ethical and respectful environment that reinforces SAC's identity as a community of global citizens.

Actions:

3.2.1 Develop an Alumni Association network that supports mentorship, promotes community engagement, and reinforces SAC's values (of global citizenship and ethical responsibility).

3.2.2 Enhance parent orientation programs and increase parent participation in key events and policies to support our students.

3.2.3 Create ways to recognise achievements by members of our community that are aligned with school culture, vision and values.





We will enhance crisis management and organizational resilience to respond effectively to unforeseen challenges, ensuring the safety, wellbeing, and continuity of learning for our community.

Actions:

3.3.1 Update our crisis management framework, including scenario-based response plans and communication protocols.

3.3.2 Conduct regular drills and simulations to ensure preparedness across all departments.

3.3.3. Establish a Continuity of Learning Plan to transition smoothly to remote or hybrid learning when required.

Actions

4.1.1 We will organize student-led X-Zone conferences, workshops, and training on entrepreneurship and innovation with other schools to promote collective learning.

4.1.2 We will attend national & international competitions to inspire our students about our creative use of technology.

4.1.3 We will develop a sustainable Educational Technology budget that allows us to invest in new and emerging technologies to enhance and support student learning.

4.1.4 We will establish a teacher-led research initiative focused on innovation, educational technology, and sustainable practices, with opportunities to collaborate, present findings, and implement pilot projects.

GOAL 2

We will empower our students to be visionary leaders who serve for the benefit of their community.

Actions

4.2.1 Implement a structured program to develop students' skills in ethical decision-making, facilitation, and service-oriented leadership, empowering them to lead community projects aligned with SAC's core values.

4.2.2 Ensure that club leaders have specific time to collaborate on service projects, clear avenues to communicate with administration and access to a budget to support their proposed projects.





4.2.3 We will establish a mentorship and networking program connecting SAC students with alumni and tech leaders to foster leadership, innovation, and community service initiatives.

GOAL 3

We will educate our students to be digital citizens who engage with media and technologies critically and in ways that foster creativity, and ethical media engagement leading to positive societal impact.

Actions:

4.3.1 Create opportunities for students to demonstrate the responsible use of media and technologies.

4.3.2 Implement a digital literacy and technology skills program that empowers students to use technology effectively and responsibly for learning, problem-solving, and collaboration.

Actions:

5.2.2 Strengthen SAC's connection and bond with SEV Çekmeköy Schools by facilitating joint global citizenship projects.

Actions:

- **5.3.1:** Foster a culture of sustainability at SAC by embedding environmentally conscious practices into all systems and operations, aligning with international standards such as the Global Schools Program and the SDGs, to reduce waste, enhance community engagement, and integrate sustainability into school operations and curricula.
